### **Meeting Presentation Summary and Speaker Bio**

#### Meeting Summary:

Report on the cyber security activities on the state level.

#### Speaker Bio:

Marc Glenn has been cybersecurity professional for over twenty-three years. He's is a retired Army veteran and his career began in 1989 where he worked as a Bradley Fighting Vehicle systems engineer, telecommunications specialist and trainer. In 1998 he became a computer specialist and network engineer with the California National Guard. From 2000 to 2014, Glenn worked with the Department of Defense in various roles culminating in his assignment as the California National Guard's Chief Information Security Officer (CISO).

In July of 2014 Marc began working for the Employment Development Department creating the department's first Network Operations and Security Center (NOSC). In 2015, Marc retired from the military as the first official, J6 / G6 Sergeant Major for the California National Guard and State of California Military Department.

Marc has worked closely with various companies and governmental agencies around the world including teaching Cybersecurity courses at Heald College and ITT Technical Institute. Marc has numerous certifications and has helped create and mature cyber programs for the Department of Defense, NSA, US CERT, ACERT, SANS Institute, Comp TIA, NATO, and The Ministry of Defense for Macedonia, the California Highway Patrol, the State of California ISO and most recently, the California Cybersecurity Integration Center in Rancho Cordova California.

Marc lives and works in Sacramento with his wife Georgie and there 3 children.

- Slight right to stay on Webster St
- Continue onto Webster St Tube
- Use the right lane to continue on CA-61 S/Webster Street Tube and follow signs for Webster St.
- Use the 2<sup>nd</sup> from the right lane to turn sharply right onto Willie Stargell Ave
- Turn right onto Mariner Square Loop
- Turn right onto Marina Village Parkway
- Turn left onto Mariner Square Dr.

Restaurant is on your right by the water, across from Oakmont Cardinal Point retirement living.

FROM the EAST:

- I-580 W toward San Francisco
- Use the right 2 lanes to take exit 19D toward I-980/Downtown/Interstate 880
- Continue onto I-980 W
- Use the right 2 lanes to take exit 1C for 12<sup>th</sup> St
- Merge onto Brush St
- Turn left onto 7<sup>th</sup> St
- Use the right 2 lanes to turn right onto Webster St
- Slight right to stay on Webster St
- Continue onto Webster Street Tube
- Use the right lane to continue on CA-61 S/Webster Street Tube and follow signs for Webster St.
- Use the 2<sup>nd</sup> from the right lane to turn sharply right onto Willie Stargell Ave
- Turn right onto Mariner Square Loop
- Turn right onto Marina Village Parkway

- I-880 N to Oakland. Take exit 41B toward Broadway/Downtown

- Slight right to stay on Webster St.
- Continue onto Webster St Tube
- Use the right lane to continue on CA-61 S/Webster Street Tube and follow signs for Webster St
- Use the 2<sup>nd</sup> from the right lane to turn sharply right onto Willie Stargell Ave
- Turn right onto Mariner Square Loop
- Turn right onto Marina Village Parkway
- Turn left onto Mariner Square Dr.
